At Family Recovery Center we understand the severity of the disease of addiction; therefore, we will remain open. FRC wants to keep everyone informed that we will continue providing services while keeping current clients and staff members safe and well.

FRC has taken the following actions:

- FRC has taken necessary precautions by implementing cleaning procedures, which include frequent, thorough hand-washing, sanitizing surfaces, and having the inside of our buildings professionally cleaned and disinfected.
  - Masks and gloves are available to staff, as well.
- FRC has asked all employees, if they are feeling ill to stay home; FRC has asked all clients that are feeling ill to utilize telehealth instead of coming in for counseling.
  - Ensuring the health and safety of employees and those we serve is our primary goal.

Furthermore, FRC has *temporarily suspended* group counseling. FRC is also utilizing telehealth, in an effort, to continue providing holistic counseling services to clients in Jefferson and Columbiana Counties; especially for clientele who are not feeling well. Telehealth will be made available to those who have access to technology and will be utilized for individuals receiving assessments, individual counseling sessions, and case management.
